Embracing the Mystery

The Christian confession of a triune God cannot be explained, it can only be believed. It is not a cop-out to proclaim that this belief is rooted in mystery. Mystery is the essential language and experience of belief. We lose something when we try to explain a mystery instead of embracing it. It may make us uncomfortable; it may provoke more questions than answers. Regardless, it does not suggest the weakness of mystery but rather the beauty, the wonder, and the awe.

Embracing belief and living as a person of faith is a singular journey. You cannot believe for someone else, and that person, even one you dearly love, cannot believe for you. It is also important to understand that as singular as the journey of faith may be, it ultimately ends in community. Belief does not isolate a person, but rather invites a person to connect with others who also walk in faith.

The community/communion of the triune God—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—is the perfect witness to the truth that mystery creates. One God, three divine persons. The Eucharist that we celebrate on this day proclaims the unity of our belief—to the Father, through the Son, by the power of the Holy Spirit. ●

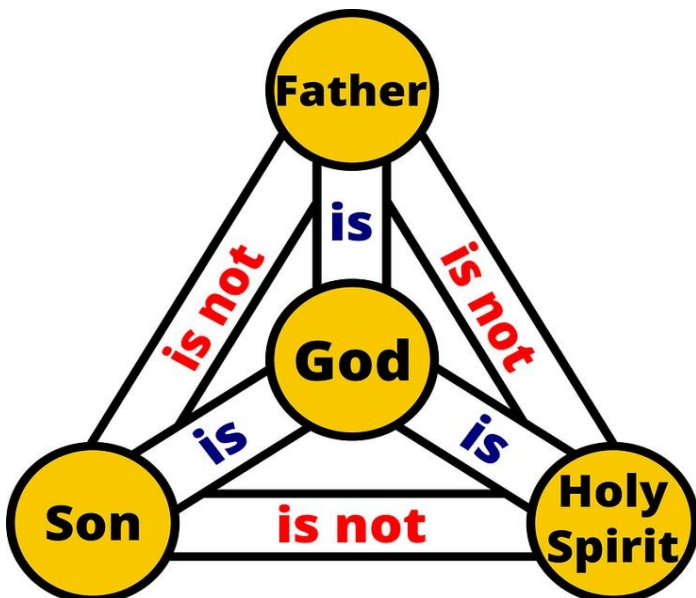

PRO-LIFE NEWS

A Catholic priest, recovering from a hip fracture at Vancouver General Hospital, says he was offered medical assistance in dying (MAiD) twice as a future option in case his life situation worsened, according to a report from The BC Catholic. Vancouver Coastal Health Region issued a statement saying that MAiD may be brought up by staff who have training and knowledge about it.

Amanda Achtman, founder of the anti-euthanasia initiative "Dying to Meet You" and Ethics Director at Canadian Physicians for Life, said unsolicited MAiD discussions can act as a form of coercion and degradation.

The Province of Alberta introduced a bill titled "Safeguards for Last Resort Termination of Life Act" in March, which passed in April, though it has not yet been proclaimed into law. The legislation limits proactive promotion or offers of MAiD and strengthens provincial safeguards surrounding the provision of physician-assisted suicide.

We have just heard about the Ascension of Jesus into Heaven and the Holy Spirit Jesus sent down upon the Apostles. But there is something that seems confusing: The Holy Spirit came down to forgive ALL sins. What does it mean when Jesus says, "... except against the Holy Spirit."

THE UNFORGIVABLE SIN?

What Blasphemy Against the Holy Spirit Really Means

The Church is crystal clear that there are "no limits to the mercy of God." (CCC 1864) Jesus Christ died for everyone's sins, and anyone who repents of his sins and follows Christ can receive forgiveness and new life.

Jesus' quote from Mark 3:28-29 says: "Truly, I say to you, all sins will be forgiven the children of man, and whatever blasphemies they utter, but whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit never has forgiveness, but is guilty of an eternal sin."

The Catechism addresses this teaching directly: "There are no limits to the mercy of God, but anyone who deliberately refuses to accept His mercy by repenting, rejects the forgiveness of his sins and the salvation offered by the Holy Spirit. Such hardness of heart can lead to final impenitence and eternal loss." (CCC1864)

In other words, the Catechism says that "blasphemy of the Holy Spirit" is rejecting the forgiveness of God all the way to the end of one's life. It's blasphemy of the Holy Spirit because salvation is offered to every person by the Holy Spirit.

St. Thomas Aquinas explains it this way, that it is a question of a sin that is "unforgivable" by its very nature, insofar as it excludes the elements through which the forgiveness of sin takes place.

"According to such an exegesis, 'blasphemy' does not properly consist in offending against the Holy Spirit in words; it consists rather in the refusal to accept the salvation which God offers to man through the Holy Spirit, working through the power of the Cross."

We should not be worried about sinning so badly that God can't forgive it *if we repent*. No such sin exists. But we should be wary about refusing God's forgiveness.

After we die there will be no second chances. In his loving kindness, God has offered us a chance for salvation. We should humbly and speedily repent of our sins and accept God gratuitous gift of grace.

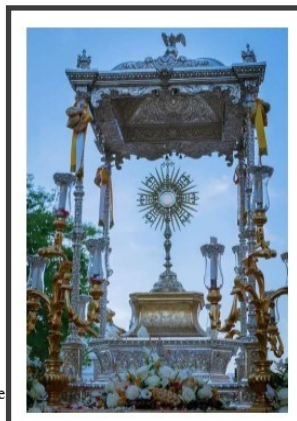

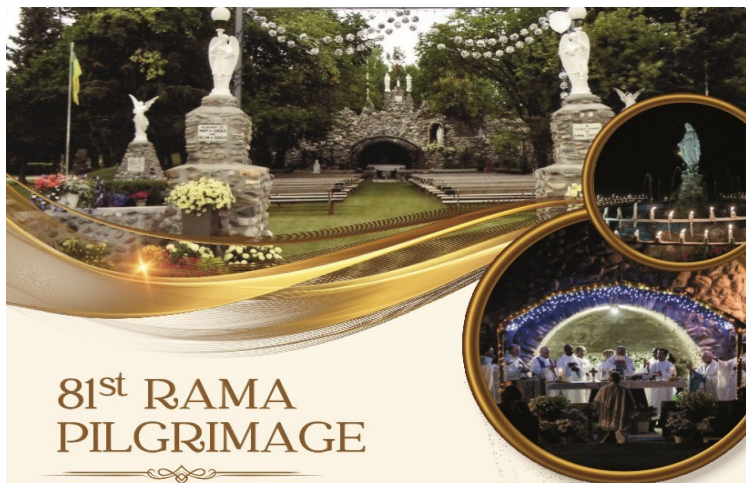
STEWARDSHIP BULLETIN BITS

BULLETIN REFLECTION

On Holy Trinity Sunday, we are invited into the mystery of God’s inner life, not as something distant or abstract, but as something revealed through love. In today’s Gospel, Jesus Christ gives us perhaps the most well-known summary of that mystery: “God so loved the world that He gave His only Son.” The Trinity is not first a concept to be explained, but a relationship to be received. The Father gives. The Son is given. The Spirit is poured out. At the heart of God is not isolation, but self-giving love, that reaches outward to us. As we reflect on the Trinity, we are reminded that we are drawn into this divine life. Through our faith, our relationships, and our generosity, we participate in the love that God is.
